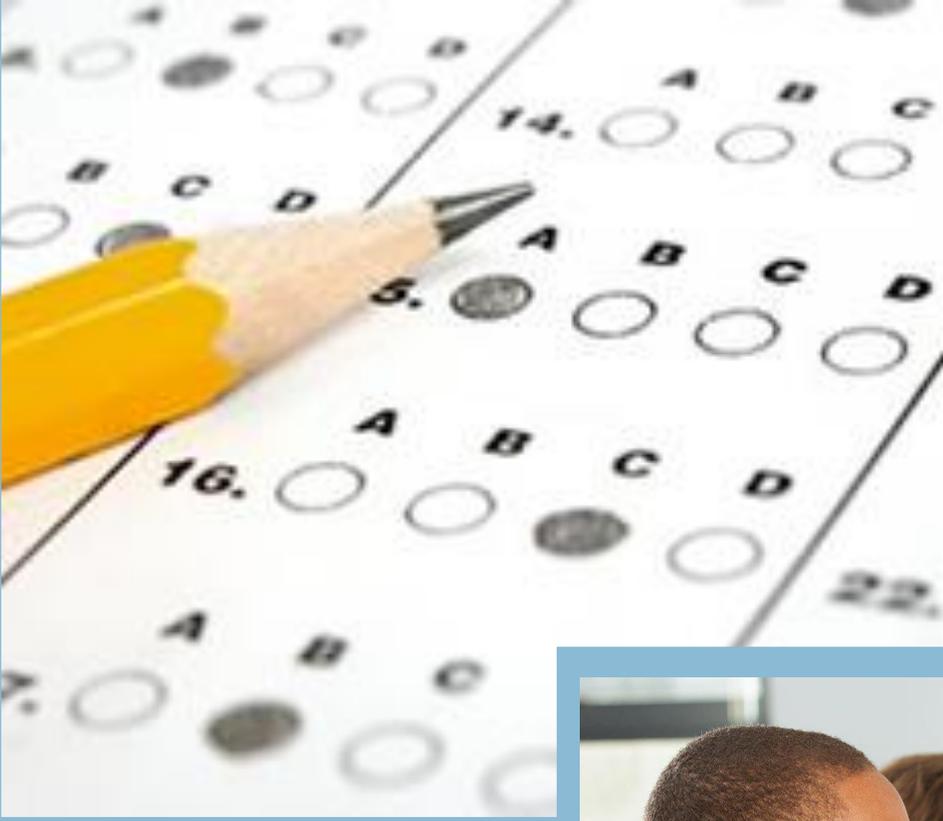

Screening, Diagnostic, and Progress Monitoring

- Universal Screening Assessments
- Diagnostic Assessments
- Progress Monitoring Assessment

and Progress

Assessments**



Why? Universal Screening & Diagnostic

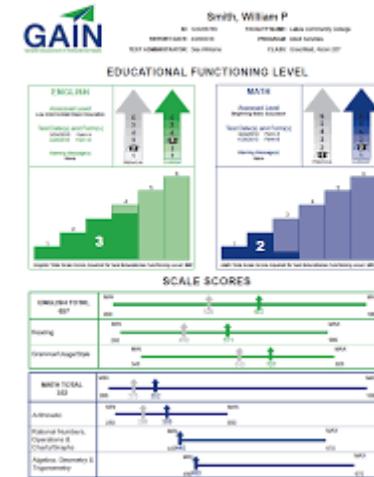
- Determines a student's **overall academic performance** level
- Identifies students who may benefit from **additional services** or supports
- Identifies student **strengths and weaknesses**
- Pinpoints **specific learning needs** to guide academic curricular and instructional decisions
- Monitors student **growth**

**Reading Plus Placement Assessment
Administered During Orientation**

Why? Progress Monitoring

- Used for students receiving **academic support/interventions**
- Given **frequently** to measure the development of **foundational skills** needed to master standards
- **Finely-tuned**
- Measure **incremental growth**



GAIN Assessment
Administered 3X Yearly

Standards-Based Assessments

Used before, during, or after instruction to monitor student progress towards grade level standards

- Pre-Assessments
- Formative Assessments
- Unit/Summative Assessments
- Benchmark Assessments
- Authentic Assessment
- Recovery Assessment

**Standards-Based
Assessments**



Pre-Assessments

Administered during Credit Recovery Courses

- Occur **prior to the start** of an instructional cycle
- Measure a student's **prior knowledge and skills**
- Designed to **inform teacher's instruction** and **respond to student needs**
- Not used for a student's grade





Why? **Unit/Summative Assessments**

- Administered at the **end of an instructional cycle**
- Used to **evaluate student mastery** of the standards
- Can be used to determine a student's grade.

All grades/courses



Authentic Assessments Projects, Discussions, Labs, etc.

- Requires that students engage with **real-life** problems, issues, or tasks for an audience who cares about or has a stake in what students learn
- Enables students to make sense of and apply what they have learned and to establish **clear connections** between what they have learned in schools and the world in which they live
- Can be used as a grade

- Standardized criterion-referenced assessments
- Standardized norm-referenced assessments

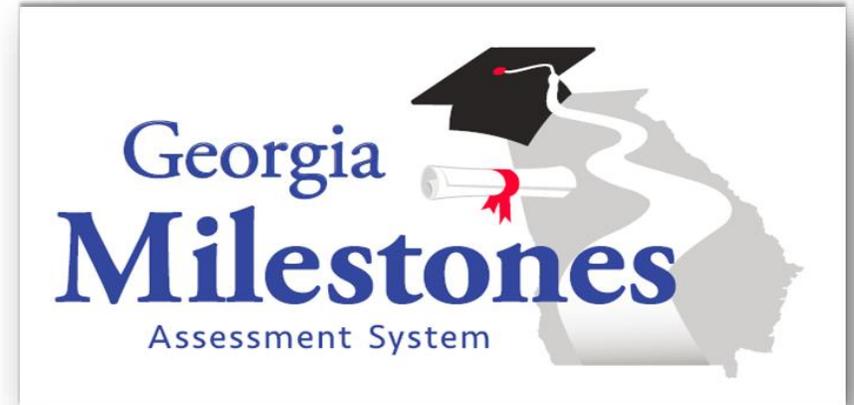

Standardized Criterion-Referenced Assessments

- Evaluates learning at the end of a long-term instructional period (e.g., end of course or grade)
- Determines whether each student has achieved **proficiency** on a set of required skills and concepts
- Should not be used as a grade *except as required by state law*



**Specific courses set by
Georgia DOE**



- Administered on the computer
- Students score in four categories: *Beginning, Developing, Proficient, or Advanced*
- Provides valuable information about student learning to students, parents, teachers, district staff, state, and community stakeholders

Standardized Norm-Referenced Assessments

- Evaluate students on **broad areas** of knowledge
- Serve to **classify** or **rank** students on a continuum of achievement compared to their peers
- Not used as a grade

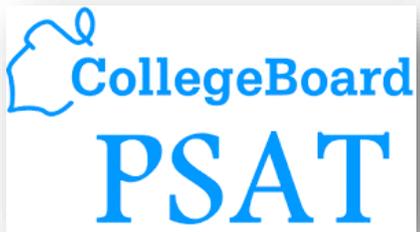
